### Physician

- Current Texas license
- Family Practice, Internal Medicine, Endocrinology, or Emergency Medicine
- Bilingual (Spanish) a plus
- Daytime and evening volunteer opportunities are available
- Shifts are less than three hours and patient load can be adjusted
- One to two physicians per clinic

### Nurse

- Registered Nurse or Licensed Vocational Nurse with valid Texas license
- Two years patient care experience
- Current CPR Certification
- Interest in community health and willingness to work in team environment!
- Three nurses per clinic

### Pharmacist

- Current Texas license
- Patient counseling skills
- Basic computer skills for sample medication management
- Wants to make a difference in the lives of others!
- Two pharmacists per clinic

### Interpreter

- Bilingual and proficient in both English and Spanish
- Willing to learn medical terminology
- Translate for patients and clinicians
- Enjoys being part of a team!
- Two or three translators per clinic

#### Intake and Exit desk Receptionists

- Basic computer skills for patient registration and scheduling appointments
- Bilingual (Spanish) a plus
- Intake: Registration of patients coming to clinic, filing forms in chart
- Exit Desk: Check patients out of clinic after they receive medical care
- Must be organized and enjoy patient contact!
- One intake and an exit desk receptionist per clinic

#### Health Educators

- Health care professionals licensed and/or certified to provide education related to nutrition, exercise, diabetes, heart disease, obesity and other health-related topics
- Group and individual education opportunities are available
- Two years patient care experience
- Interested in community health
